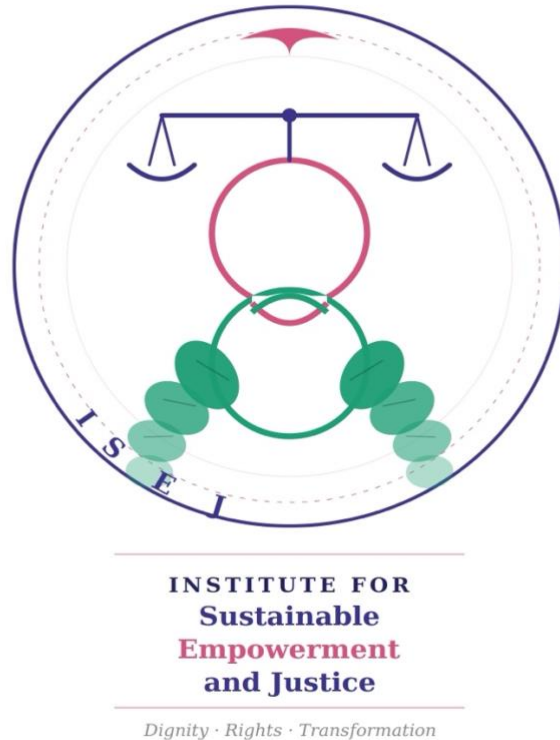


A New Look, the Same Promise: ISEJ Unveils Its New Logo



ISEJ looks a little different today. After months of reflection on who we are and where we're going, we have redesigned our logo.

Why change it? Because our identity has grown, and the old emblem no longer told the whole story.

The scales of justice are still at the centre. That is deliberate. Equitable access to justice is why ISEJ exists, and it is not going anywhere. Around them you will now see interlinked circles for the communities, survivors and grassroots movements we work with, and budding leaves for renewal and sustainability. We have always held that gender justice, climate resilience and empowerment grow together, and we wanted a logo that says so at a glance. The circular seal holds it all in one frame, because for us these were never separate pursuits.

What has not changed is the work. We remain committed to dignity, rights and transformation, standing with women, girls and marginalised communities across Zimbabwe as knowers, interpreters and authors of change.
